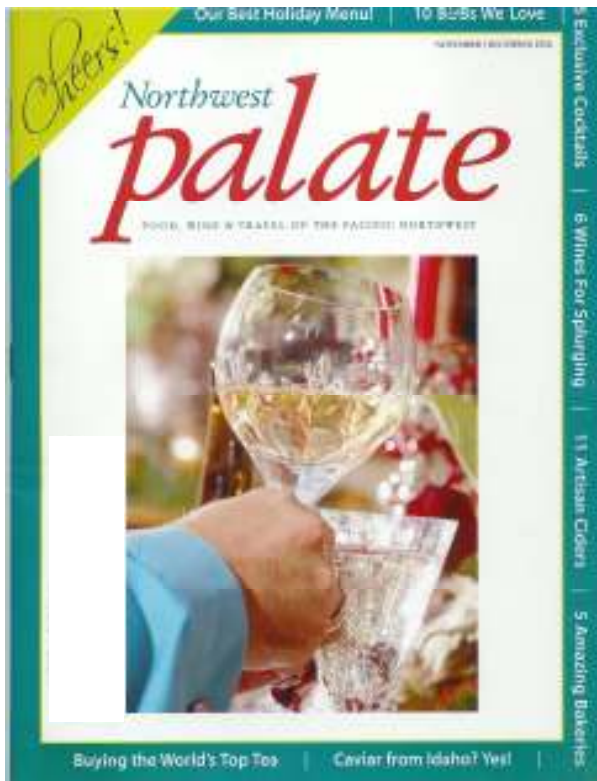

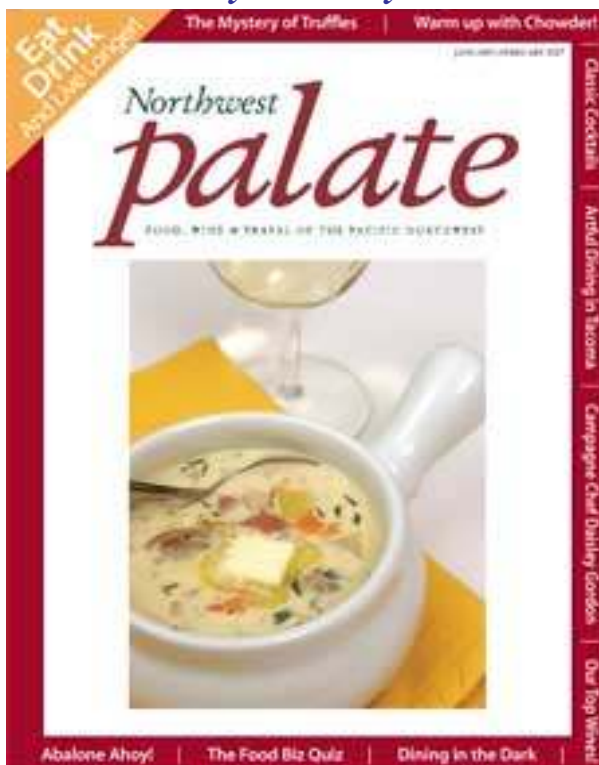

Aromas of red fruits are pertly accented by light leafy tones. Juicy on the tongue, with bright spice and floral notes lurking around substantial black cherry and raspberry fruit flavors. Broad and ripe tannins on the finish linger nicely, with hints of lilac and rose. Good with grilled guinea fowl. (480 cases made.) \$38

Full and warm scents of ripe peach and faint banana greet the nose, while on the tongue lush and somewhat heavy flavors of pear and pineapple appear with a gently oily texture. This ripe Pinot Gris would pair well with sea bass and a red pepper coulis to lighten the wine. (117 cases made.) \$22
