### ArborBrook Vineyards 2009 Guadalupe Pinot Gris

<i>Blend</i>	100% Guadalupe Vineyard Pinot Gris

#### Winegrower's Notes

A barrel-fermented Pinot Gris with fruit sourced from the exclusive Guadalupe Vineyard in the Dundee Hills, it is reminiscent of those from Alsace and very rare in Oregon, this wine displays warmth and richness in a subtle, spicy nose that continues into the palate with fullness and hints of ripe pear, spice, vanilla, peach, honeydew, apricot and stone fruits. Aged sur lees for eleven months in a combination of new, second and third year French oak, the soft mouthfeel of this wine lingers long on your palate and displays further hints of mango and other tropical fruit, giving away into a long finish that shows hints of gentle lemon and mandarin oranges. This is a complex and beautiful Pinot Gris that will pair well with rich foods such as butternut squash bisque or spicy foods requiring a wine with more significant structure. Drink now through 2016.
