A barrel-fermented Pinot Gris with fruit sourced from the exclusive Guadalupe Vineyard in the Dundee Hills, it is reminiscent of those from Alsace and very rare in Oregon, this wine displays ripe fruits, a full, round mouthfeel and a lasting finish with hints of vanilla. This is a complex and beautiful Pinot Gris that will pair well with rich foods such as oyster on half shell with cucumber relish, calamari with lemon garlic aioli, halibut with mango lime salsa, or prawns in yellow curry sauce.
