

Winegrower's Notes

A barrel-fermented Pinot Gris with fruit sourced from the exclusive Guadalupe Vineyard in the Dundee Hills, it is reminiscent of those from Alsace and very rare in Oregon, this wine displays ripe fruits, a full, round mouth-feel and a lasting finish. A beautiful Pinot Gris with aromas of ripe pear, orange blossom, kiwi, white raisins, and a hint of citrus. The palate has a perfect balance of richness and acidity with honeydew, star fruit, and crisp apple. Enjoy with spicy dishes or rich seafood. Great now through 2020.
