This wine explodes with a beautiful bouquet of lemon, grapefruit and kiwi and transitions to a silky and full mouthfeel, unusual for a stainless fermented Pinot Gris. The richness of this wine is being driven by the warm weather that we saw in 2009, tempered wonderfully by the coastal influence of the location of the Croft Vineyard, rising up into the coastal foothills of this site in rural Polk County near Monmouth, Oregon. The captivating nose of this wine transcends into wonderful hints of Meyers lemons, orange blossom, and ripe pear, and finishes with a soft creaminess in the finish that lingers long on the palate. Enjoy this wine on the deck this summer with scallops, ceviche and good friends!
