In search of Mary's favorite summer wine, we produced this stunning Sauvignon Blanc that will quench any summertime palate or pair amazing with so many dishes. You're drawn in by the grapefruit, star fruit, honeydew, orange blossom, mineral slate, lemon/lime citrus, and a hint of green apple. In the palate your mouth comes alive with the crisp citrus tones, beautiful minerality, and an acidity that lingers without overpowering. Enjoy sipping in the sun or pair with oysters on the half shell, crab cakes with lemon sauce, lobster pasta with beurre blanc sauce, prosciutto wrapped honeydew, sautéed shrimp with anchovies, mussels or razor clams.
