ArborBrook Vineyards 2014 Guadalupe Vineyard Pinot Gris

Winegrower's Notes

A barrel-fermented Pinot Gris with fruit sourced from the exclusive Guadalupe Vineyard in the Dundee Hills, it is reminiscent of those from Alsace and very rare in Oregon. Full bodied Pinot Gris that has a lush long finish that is bright and rich at the same time. Aromas of orange blossom, white raisins, a hint of citrus, ripe pear and a hint of toasted nuts. In the palate you also get some apple and star fruit that is well balanced with richness and touch of acidity for a long finish. Enjoy with spicy dishes, savory clam chowder, mushroom risotto, Cajun dishes, or holiday meals. Great now through 2024.
